



How to separate and dispose of domestic waste

Fukuyama City

Illegal dumping is a crime.

Use transparent or translucent garbage bags so that the contents are visible.
Check the municipal garbage collection schedule before taking garbage out.
Please separate your garbage properly. Un-separated garbage will not be collected.
Sort your garbage correctly, remove all water/liquid from it, and put your garbage out on its designated day, time, and place.

Combustible bulky waste	Please take a look at the collection schedule for combustible bulky waste.	<p>Wood furniture</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Desks ● Chairs ● Cabinets Beds ● Chests, etc. <p>Bed products</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Carpets Blankets Spring mattress Comforters, Futons <p>Dry element cell</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dry element batteries Ni-Cd Batteries are not collected. Take them to retail store. <p>Media tapes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Video cassette tapes Audio cassette tapes, etc. <p>Lighters</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please use up contents and place in a clear plastic bag. <p>* Before throwing out breakable items, please place back in the box it came in (or similar box), make sure that it won't break, and then take it outside.</p> <p>* Incandescent light bulbs are "unburnable garbage".</p> <p>* When buying replacement equipment, as much as possible, please have the store you bought the new one from take your old one back.</p>	
Items that are not collected by Fukuyama City		<p>Soil and sand, stones, blocks, etc.</p> <p>Soil and sand, stones, blocks, concrete, sand for pet use, tatami mats.</p> <p>Massage chairs etc.</p> <p>Massage Chairs, electronic pianos, kerosene heater</p> <p>Large amount of garbage at a time</p> <p>Large amount of garbage due to moving, housecleaning, pruning trees, or so.</p> <p>Business-generated waste</p> <p>Business waste discharged from business activities of stores, factories, offices and etc.</p> <p>Special electrical appliances</p> <p>Air conditioners ● Flat Screen and CRT Televisions ● Refrigerators ● Freezers ● Washing machines ● Clothes Dryer ● Personal Computers</p> <p>Non-acceptable garbage (Items that are not collected by the municipal garbage collection services)</p> <p>Bikes ● Tires ● Agricultural machinery ● Car batteries ● Agricultural chemicals ● Compressed gas cylinders ● Fire extinguishers ● Pianos ● Fireproof safe</p>	<p>Though disposing of them yourself is the main option, you may also take them to the municipal refuse disposal facility if the amount is small.</p> <p>In principle you are responsible to dispose of them, however, you may also take them to the municipal refuse disposal facility if the amount is small.</p> <p>★ Dispose of them yourself or take it to the municipal refuse disposal facility. Or, ask a city-approved refuse collection company to take the waste.</p> <p>The city will not collect this garbage. Take appropriate disposal measures.</p> <p>★ Do not take them to the municipal refuse disposal facility.</p> <p>★ Take appropriate disposal measures such as contacting the store from which the appliance (and similar items) was originally bought and asking them to dispose of it.</p>
